


- International Computer Chess Association (ICCA) formed in 1977 to promote research in Al applied to chess

7	2020	WCCC co-located with ECAI in Santiago de Compostela Cancelled WCCC, Olympiad, CG conference
7	2021	Olympiad and ACG conference held online
7	2022	WCCC co-located with IJCAI, held in Vienna, Austria Olympiad and CG conference held online
7	2023	WCCC held in Valencia, Spain Olympiad and ACG conference held online
7	2024	WCCC co-located with ECAI in Santiago de Compostela Olympiad and CG conference held online

President's Report (3)

- Hoped that the move to online would help with Olympiad participation, and it has to some extent (# entries up; # of participants up)
- Hoped that the move to online would help with the number of ACG and CG paper submissions:
 - Initially no, but this year has seen a nice increase (37)
 - Were able to attract some big speakers who ordinarily would not have come to the conference
 - Online interest has been high, but actual attendance much lower
- Continued WCCC as an in-person event

President's Report (4)

- Recommend continuing online Olympiads and conferences
 - Must advertise them beyond the current mailing lists that we use
 - 7 This helped stabilize (and even improve) our financial position
- Pressing issues:
 - Increasing the number of ICGA members
 - Increasing the number of submissions to the ICGA Journal
